

# Did You Know?

Spring 2008 TerraNova Standardized Testing Scores revealed that St. Ann students consistently meet or exceed expectations across the disciplines. In fact, our math scores showed that we range from six months (2nd grade) to two and a half years (7th grade) ahead of the national averages, with gradual increases as our students progress through each successive grade.

All of our students in grades K through 8 benefit from regular Spanish classes with a full-time Spanish teacher; Kindergartners through 4th graders meet once weekly, and 5th through 8th graders receive two lessons per week.

Our new, dedicated science lab is fully outfitted and ready for use by the 6th, 7th and 8th grade classes.

Our computer lab features more than 30 computers, many of which are under two years old.

St. Ann School's new Fundraising Committee—comprised of roughly 30 enthusiastic parents and teachers—has revamped some of our stand-by efforts and planned several new and exciting events for the coming year.

The old School Board with its limited advisory capacity no longer exists. We're currently in the process of seeking members for a new Board of Specified Jurisdiction, which will have decision-making authority in several areas, including marketing, finance and enrollment.

Several of our current 8th grade students begin their days at Marian Catholic High School where they take high school credit classes in Honors Biology and Advanced Algebra.

100 percent of the funds raised by school fundraisers are used for school purposes.

Our new all-day preschool program, combined with before and after school Extended Day care, offers more options than ever before for working families and those with variable schedules.
