

## 2016-2017 REQUIRED SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

Every school family must contribute at least 10 hours per year in service to our school activities and events. If a parent is unable to fulfill the requirement, other family members (grandparents, aunts, uncles, adult siblings, etc.) may participate. Please make three choices from the list below and number them in order of preference, sign, and return the bottom portion to the office. Some service opportunities may fill up, so spaces will be claimed on a first-come/first-served basis, and we will let you know for which activities you're selected to help. Serving on a committee will likely satisfy your entire requirement, while some other opportunities may count hourly toward your 10 hour total. For instance, working a shift at an event will only take an hour or two, making participation in more than one opportunity necessary. We will provide a time-sheet for you to track your hours and have them signed off by a coordinator. If you achieve at least 10 service hours, you will receive a \$100 tuition credit on your last payment of the year. Of course, any family who is able to put in more than 10 hours will be greatly appreciated! **All hours accrued by March 31, 2017 will qualify.**

**FRANKFEST** – help at our annual back to school party (September)

**BOOK FAIR** – help the children shop for books during school hours at our annual Scholastic Book Fair (Oct.)

**HALLOWEEN PANCAKE BREAKFAST** – serve on the committee and/or work the event (October)

**SANTA'S SECRET SHOP** – help the children shop for gifts during school hours at our annual Shop (Dec.)

**BALL IN THE HALL** – serve on one of the committees and/or work the event (March)

**GOOD NEIGHBOR DAY PARADE** – help with the float; walk in the parade and distribute flyers/supervise candy distribution by the kids (first Saturday of May)

**TECHIE TROT** – secure donations; serve on a committee; assist the day of the event (June)

**HOME & SCHOOL ASSOCIATION** – attend monthly meetings and assist with HSA events as they arise (Movie Night, Daddy/Daughter Dance, Mother/Son Bowling, etc.)

**PARENT AMBASSADORS** – participate in recruiting and retention efforts, such as touring prospective families, community outreach, and acting as a resource for new and existing parents

**LUNCH/RECESS HELPERS** – assist in the lunchroom and supervise on the playground on days you are available between the hours of 11:15 a.m. - Noon

**PLAYGROUP ASSISTANCE** – help with planning and directing Little Roughriders, our weekly play group for newborns through 3-year-olds and their caregivers, which meets on Wednesday mornings from 9-10:00 a.m.

**PARKING LOT SAFETY** – direct traffic in the morning (7:30-8:00 a.m.) and/or ensure cars are parked properly for afternoon pickup and that all children safely find their vehicles (2:15-2:45 p.m.)
